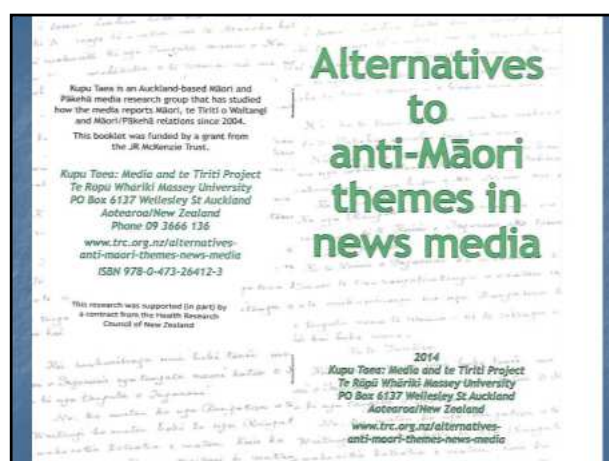

'Maori culture'

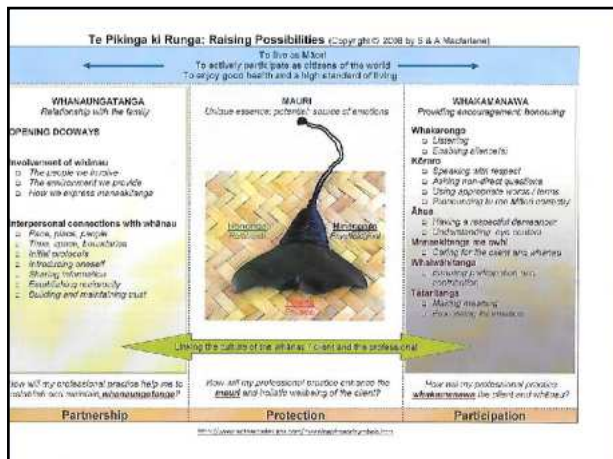
primitive **language** **holds them back** **for the PC** **is limited** **inadequate for today** **sexist** **Stone Age**

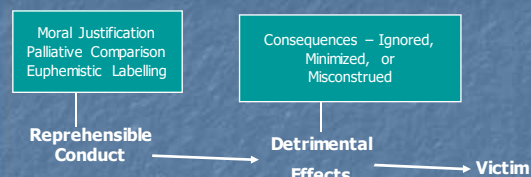
Elements in moral self-assessment



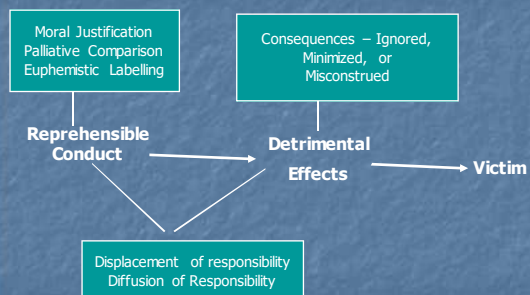
Contributions to Moral Disengagement
